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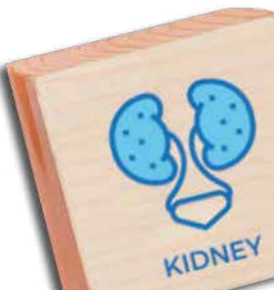

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WHAT IS HEALTH SCREENING?

Health screening helps to identify risk factors and early stages of diseases. Early detection leads to a higher chance of recovery. Absence of any symptom does not indicate that you are healthy.





WHAT AGE SHOULD I START HEALTH SCREENING?

There are different tests that you can take depending on your age.

GENERAL SCREENING FOR ADULTS

Recommended for	To screen for	Screening test	Screening frequency
Individuals aged 18 years and above	Obesity	Body Mass Index (BMI) Waist circumference	Once a year
	High Blood Pressure	Blood Pressure measurement	Once every two years or more frequently as advised by your doctor
Individuals aged 40 years and above	Diabetes mellitus	Fasting blood glucose HbA1c	Once every three years or more frequently as advised by your doctor
	High blood cholesterol	Fasting lipids Non-fasting lipids	Once every three years or more frequently as advised by your doctor
Individuals aged 50 years and above	Colorectal cancer	Faecal Immunochemical Test (to test for blood in stools) OR	Once a year

ADDITIONAL TESTS FOR WOMEN

Recommended for	To screen for	Screening test	Screening frequency
Women aged 25- 69 years, who have had sexual intercourse	Cervical cancer	Pap test	Once every three years
		HPV test	Once every five years
Women aged 50- 69 years	Breast cancer	Mammogram	Once every two years

WHAT DO I DO AFTER I RECEIVE MY RESULTS?



If the results are normal, you can continue your lifestyle as usual and go for regular screening at the recommended intervals. If you develop any symptoms before the next scheduled screening or medical appointment, contact your doctor as soon as possible.

If the results are abnormal, you should contact your doctor immediately even if you feel perfectly fine. Receiving treatment early may help prevent or delay complications.
