**NOTICE TO VISITORS: UPDATED PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR COVID-19**

Cases of COVID-19 have been reported around the world, and cases are still being reported daily in Singapore.

SATA CommHealth is taking additional precautions as advised by the Ministry of Health to reduce the number of visitors.

- 1) Caregivers and patients will have to register with us before they are allowed entry. We will only be able to allow **one visitor** accompanying each client at a time.
- 2) **Temperature screening** will be done for all entering our medical centres.
- 3) We will be asking all clients/ residents and visitors for their personal details (e.g. NRIC, name, contact details), **health status** and **travel history**.

Please inform our staff if you:

- (a) are unwell (i.e. have respiratory symptoms, cough, shortness of breath); or
- (b) have been to any country outside Singapore in the last 14 days
- (c) have been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case within the last 14 days or is on Stay Home Notice (SHN)

**Patients who have been to any country outside Singapore or were in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case or on Stay Home Notice within the last 14 days will NOT be allowed entry into our medical centres.**

Under the Infectious Diseases Act, anyone making a false declaration can be prosecuted.
